The Buzz Around Culture

Willis Towers Watson states in its 23rd Annual Best Practices in Health Care Employer Survey that enhancing employee perceptions about the work place cul-

ture is one of the top three priorities for employers. But what does workplace culture really mean? A few define it as the personality of the organization. Others may refer to the mission of the company. Many may use it to describe the work environment. Each of us instantly have concepts that come to mind as we describe our workplace and how we perceive ourselves and our role in the organization.

Ask fellow co-workers their perception of the culture in your workplace and the answers may vary, even within departments. "This is a great place to work; this is my second family!" "I do not feel that I am trusted or respected." "They care about employees learning and developing, and my contributions matter." "We work in silos and I do not understand how my responsibilities play a part in the objectives of the company."

Culture directly influences employee performance. Collective purpose and mutual respect in any company is paramount to achieving a positive culture. When companies have a clearly defined business strategy and team members feel valued as they work toward a com-

mon goal, pride in the organization will flourish. Employees that believe they are respected take ownership of their position and initiate opportunities that promote the business. These employees support others around them and work to collaborate on teams, typically achieving higher rates of productivity and experiencing less stress.

Employees trust an employer when they understand their purpose and how if affects the entire organization. Understanding the "why" leads to higher employee morale and a clear vision. When employees realize the job they are doing makes a difference, employee engagement thrives. Leaders must hold themselves accountable to higher standards than they set for their teams. The strongest leaders are highly effective communicators sharing goals, successes and changes, and actively solicit feedback from their team. Rather, they are each holding themselves to a higher collective goal.

Intentionally celebrate successes of the team, and employees will become dedicated to the team rather than personal achievements. Opportunities to mentor will create strong relationships and build trust. Develop leaders by growing their

skill sets, empowering them and inspiring them to value their team members. A company with high morale benefits from job satisfaction, increased productivity and efficiency and lower stress rates among employees.

Creating a positive work culture demands intentional planning. A mistake many employers make is letting the company culture form organically and not spend time defining the culture they wish to develop. When employees understand and can tell a story about their job and how they are integral in helping their clients thrive, employees take ownership and work toward the common goals to achieve company objectives. When leaders realize that the employees are the center of the company and revenue is secondary, the culture will thrive.

Company culture is a fundamental component of every business and without a positive culture it is difficult to have satisfied employees who find value in their work. 
